A Attending to God

- *Worship and spirituality*

We will continue to offer a daily Eucharist, including Thursday evenings, and we will encourage greater attendance at these services.

We will continue to encourage children to take a full part in our Sunday worship.

We will revitalise our musical tradition and refurbish or replace our current organ.

We will revise and update our Daily Intercessions rota to make it a more effective tool for prayer, pastoral care and communications.

- *Christian giving and stewardship*

We will encourage more people to join the Parish Giving Scheme.

We will appoint a Stewardship Co-ordinator.

B Building Christian Community

- *Lay and ordained ministry*

We will continue to support the Additional Curates Society through our Lent Lunches.

We will pray for Lucy Nagel as she prepares for ordained ministry in the Church.

We will build up our list of Lay Ministers of Communion.

We will investigate the possibility of having a Parish Nurse.

- *Ministry with children and young people and in our schools*

We will run a Holiday Bible Club for primary school children at February half-term.

We will try to forge better links with local schools through Church visits and invitations to special events, including Christingle services for the Children’s Society.

We will promote participation by our children and young people in the Walsingham Children’s and Youth pilgrimages.

We will investigate holding occasional evening services aimed especially at children and young people.

C Commending God’s love for the world

- *Evangelism and apologetics*

We will offer an annual course where people can explore the Christian faith together and see how it can be lived out each day.

- *Social responsibility in the community*

We will consider the purchase of a mini-bus for use by church and community groups.

We will continue to offer monthly Coffee Mornings and advertise them more widely.

We will seek ways of supporting the Glenlogie night refuge for the homeless.

- *Partnership with the wider church*

We will invite members of other churches to join in the annual Palm Procession and social events.

We will continue to support the Church overseas through Lent Offerings in alternate years.
